KOINDAH WATERS REACHES 20,000TH GOLFER

Koindah Waters Golf Club's first ten months of operations have exceeded expectations with 20,000 golfers having played the course since opening in May 2006.

The 18 hole par 72 championship course has proved popular with golfers and experts alike with rave reviews from the local community and wider golfing fraternity since first opening its doors.

Designed by leading golf course architect Ross Watson with design input by golf professional Craig Parry, the course was designed around the natural environment to maximise the practical and aesthetic attributes of the surrounding landscape.
