## **ROOKIE SCORES SECOND HOLE IN ONE**

Social golfer, Norm Fritter, has achieved an impressive feat at the Kooindah Waters Residential Golf Resort, scoring his second hole in one in less than six months.

After playing golf for a mere two years, Norm attained his first hole in one on the par 3, 134 metre 2<sup>nd</sup> hole in August.

He scored his second 'ace' on the par 3, 147 metre 12<sup>th</sup> hole on January 14 and was presented with his second hole flag by the club and will have his name written consecutively on the club's hole in one board.

Kooindah Waters Golf Club Director of Golf Brendan Currie said it was wonderful that Norm was able to score his second hole in one at the same course where he gained his first.

"It is an outstanding achievement for a golfer to score a 'hole in one'. But for Norm to obtain his second within six months is a remarkable accomplishment," Mr Currie said.

"Most golfers never get a hole in one in a lifetime - so for Norm to score two after playing the game for only a few years is feat to be admired.

"As the longest par 3 on the course, the 12<sup>th</sup> hole proves to be a very stern test even for low markers and can often be a pivotal hole in championship play.


"Alternatively, the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole can be challenging for hitters who can run out of fairway without the right shape," he said.

Divided into three distinct character precincts, the course has been designed to be a "thinking golfer's course" where accuracy, ball placement and imagination will be the keys to scoring well.
